

Canada Customs will accept a "Statement of origin for commercial importations of less than CAN\$1,600" in lieu of a fully complete NAFTA Certificate of Origin for commercial importations of less than CAN\$1,600. This statement may be handwritten, stamped, or typed on the commercial contract or actual invoice covering the goods for which NAFTA Tariff Treatment is being claimed. Preprinted statements of origin will not be allowed on the sales invoice but are permissible on a separate form. Statements of origin for commercial importations of less than CAN\$1,600 must be prepared exactly as follows. Variations are not permitted.
